DO YOU HAVE EVERYTHING?

Make sure to have all of your documents for yourself and each person on your tax return.



Personal Information

- Picture **ID**
- Birthdate** for all persons listed on the tax return
- Social Security card** or **Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN)** card or letter for all persons listed on the tax return
- Routing and account numbers** for your savings account, checking account, and/or prepaid debit card



Income & Public Benefit Statements

- W-2s** for each job
- 1099** forms for retirement, Social Security, unemployment, interest, dividends, stock sales, and miscellaneous income
- Year-end income** for MFIP, SSI, MSA, GA, veterans' benefits, workers' compensation



Education & Child Care Credits

- Record of **educational expenses** you paid for your children in grades K-12
- Tuition expenses** for you or your child to attend a college or university (Form 1098-T)
- Student loan **interest statement** (Form 1098-E)
- Child care expenses:** Provider name, address, Tax ID, or Social Security number



Property Taxes

- Homeowners:** Mortgage interest and real estate taxes paid in 2017 and Statement of Property Tax Payable in 2018 mailed by county in March
- Renters:** Certificate of Rent Paid (CRP)



Additional Documents

- Previous year's **tax return**
- Verification of **health insurance** if purchased through MNsure (Form 1095-A)
- Record of charitable **donations**
